Ace Mikolichek - Sophomore - LIGHTING CREW



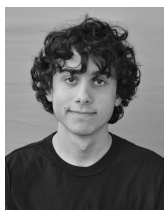

Phoebe Risser - Junior - STAGE CREW



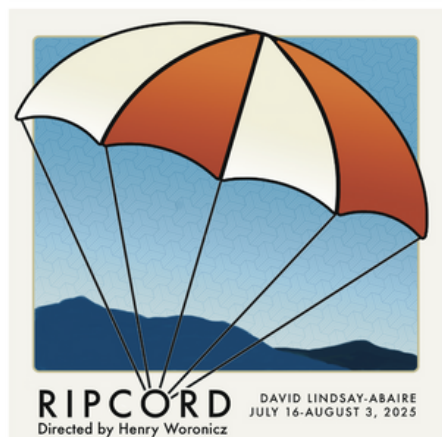
